

Stewardship 2014-2015 comparative analysis

Donors/People = individuals, couples or households

Reasons are based on personal knowledge of the donors.

Only the bookkeeper and church secretary have seen the actual figures

24 donors from 2014 did not make identifiable offerings in 2015

In 2014, those 24 donors gave a total of **\$12,239**. 8 of these people died in 2014 or early 2015, 5 moved to other parishes or out of town, 5 are now living in retirement or nursing homes, 4 of them were never regular members of All Saints'.

In 2015, there were 205 identifiable donors.

80 of these people increased their givings; **55** stayed the same.

70 donors gave less than in 2014.

Of the people whose givings decreased, **25** people gave between \$5 and \$99 less than the previous year. This segment was not scrutinized further.

8 donors decreased their offerings by more than \$1000.

The combined total of their decrease in giving between 2014 and 2015 was **\$21,480** (avg. \$2685).

Reasons for not giving to the same level in 2015 can be ascribed as follows:

37 of them decreased their givings by between \$101 and \$999.

Donations from these 37 people dropped by a combined total of **\$13,121** in 2015 (avg. \$355).
