

## Summary of Proposals presented on March 4, 2018

Each of the following proposals were presented followed by a Q & A. After all the presentations were made each person was given 8 “Red” dots (for Mission/Ministry proposals) and 3 “Blue” dots (for Capital proposals) which they were asked to place on posters around the room to indicate which proposals they “Liked”.

The number of “Likes” is indicated below.

### SWING NIGHT

A dance geared to young people with the possibility of some dance instruction. Likes = 50

### SAFE HAVEN

An after school program for neighbourhood children ages 3-13 involving arts, crafts, drama, music and board games. Purpose is two-fold: to give them, many of whom are “latch key kids”, a safe place to go, and to help build their self-esteem. Likes = 50

### AFTER SCHOOL TUTORING PROGRAM

We would offer, in cooperation with local schools, a program four afternoons a week – possibly Mon & Wed for Math and Science; Tues and Thursday for reading, writing and literature. Target participants would be grades 3 – 8. Likes = 32

### KOFFEE KLATCH

Coffee and discussion in a social setting. The group(s) could move from home to home. Anyone would be welcome. Frequency could be a couple of times a month.

Note: this proposal is similar to the “Cell Group Proposal” so perhaps they could be combined. Likes = 17

## Summary of Proposals presented on March 4, 2018

### **FORMATION OF CELL GROUPS**

Coming together with 6 to 8 members of the Parish for fellowship, sharing and most important spending time learning about the Bible. These groups could meet every week or twice a month (no less). Leadership and hosting could be shared among its members.

Likes = 11

### **BIBLE STUDY 101 – FOR BEGINNERS**

The proposal is to offer the same “Study program” three different times/week to allow all the opportunity to explore the word of God, with strategic focus on individuals and families with connections to All Saints’. Program could be offered 2 or 3 times/year and each session could be for 6 – 8 weeks. Likes = 14

### **HEAVEN SENT CAFÉ**

A community Café run on weekdays in the Parish Hall – offering coffee, tea, juices and snacks. Likes = 9

### **ALL SAINTS’ SENIORS COMMUNITY**

Establish a partnership with local Senior Organization(s) to provide senior programming in the downtown core, utilizing the Parish Hall. The goal is to provide programming designed to serve the parishioners of All Saints’ as well as seniors living in the community surrounding the parish. Likes = 24

### **MUSIC ACADEMY**

To Work in partnership with other like-minded groups to establish a Music Academy as part of our Outreach Mission. Likes = 66

## Summary of Proposals presented on March 4, 2018

### **PLANTS FOR PEOPLE**

The plan would be to rent a plot in the Stewart Street Community Garden. We would work side by side with other gardeners and help them if there is a need. We would grow food for the One Roof Community Diner. Likes = 43

### **CAPITAL PROJECT**

#### **ACCESSIBLE ENTRANCE TO THE CHURCH**

Relocate the entrance to the Office and North side of the Church. The proposal is to replace the existing window beside the washroom with an accessible door and ramp. The existing ramp would be removed and the door would be permanently closed. The added space could be used for book shelves and library materials. Likes = 23

### **CAPITAL PROJECT**

#### **OUTDOOR ELECTRONIC SIGNAGE**

Installation of Electronic Signage at front of the Church facing south on Rubidge OR possibly "V" shaped combined sign facing east on Sherbrooke St. and south on Rubidge. Likes = 43

### **CAPITAL PROJECT**

#### **UPGRADE HEATING, AIRCONDITIONING, WASHROOMS & KITCHEN OF THE PARISH HALL**

Purpose would be to make the Parish Hall a more flexible and desirable facility for parish, outreach and community events.

Project would include:

Air-condition the building; additional washroom in Upper Hall area;  
Kitchen: new stoves, griddle, dishwasher, cooler and freezer. This would lead to the kitchen being licensed by the city and fire department. Likes = 44

## Summary of Proposals presented on March 4, 2018

### **CAPTITAL PROJECT** **NARTHES CHAPEL**

Establish a flexible-space – chapel at the back of the Nave. This could be used for reflection and prayer; for small services (such as weekly daytime Eucharist); etc. Likes = 13
