Land Acknowledgement

All Saints' Peterborough resides on the sacred land of the Michi Saagiig Anishinaabeg, the first peoples of this land. We offer our respect to those ancestors who may be buried in this land. This sacred land is part of the Rice Lake Purchase, Treaty 20. All Saints' is committed to continued reconciliation with our Indigenous siblings, through continued education and the inclusion of readings from the First Nations Bible.

Liturgical Notes

- 1. In the context of Christian Liturgy, Israel does not refer to the current political state, but either to the historic Hebrews (also called Israelites) of the ancient Near East or, in Christian theology, to all people who put their faith and trust in God as the ancient peoples of God.
- 2. Younger and Elder Testament. The traditional terms for the testaments 'Old' and 'New' have been changed to Elder and Younger. This has been done as an act of equity and promise. Old and New are words in our society that add value to things often anything that is old is considered less valuable than things that are new. In our Christian context the New Testament has replaced the Old Testament, which is not only an incorrect theology, but it has also tied to it ethnic value, and antisemitic tones. The words Elder and Younger are born out of equity, and the Younger Testament is born out of the Elder Testament.

THE PROCLAMATION OF THE WORD

READING Isaiah 60:1-6, 11 Translated by Wilda C. Gafney, The Woman's Lectionary Yr C

A note about the translation, Isaiah 60 speaks to a feminine entity, Zion,—Zion not only means Jerusalem, but more importantly refers to people of one heart and one mind, following God. If read in Hebrew the feminine is clear, the translator has added that into the English translation.

A reading from the Elder testament and the writings of the prophet Isaiah.

Arise, daughter; shine, daughter; for your light has come, daughter, and the glory of the Holy One has risen upon you, daughter. For—watch now,

daughter! —bleakness shall cover the earth, and thick bleakness the peoples; and up you, daughter, the Holy One will arise, and over you daughter, God's glory will appear.

Nations shall come to your light, daughter, and royalty to the brightness of your dawn, daughter. Lift your eyes round about, daughter, and see; all of them gather, they come to you, daughter; daughter, your sons shall come from far away, and your daughters shall be carried on theirs nurses' hips. Then daughter, you shall see and be radiant; your heart, daughter, shall tremble and swell, because the abundance of the sea shall turn toward you, daughter, the wealth of the nations shall come to you, daughter. A multitude of camels shall cover you, daughter—young camels of Midian and Ephah—all of those from Sheba shall come. They shall bring gold and frankincense and shall proclaim the praises of the Holy One.

Your gates shall aways be open, daughter; day and night they shall not be shut, so that nations shall bring you their wealth, daughter, being led by their royals.

Psalm 72 is an intercession for the king and includes prayers for his righteous judgement, long life, and just worldwide rule. I invite you to read the selected verses with me.

O God, give your anointed one your judgment—and your justice.

Teach your chosen one to govern your people rightly and bring justice to the oppressed.

The mountains will bring the people peace and the hills justice!

Your anointed will defend the oppressed among the people, save the children of the poor, and crush the oppressor.

The reign of your anointed will endure as long as the sun and moon—throughout all generations.

The rule of the chosen one will be like rain coming down on the meadow, like showers watering the earth.

Justice will flower through the days, and profound peace, until the moon be no more.

Your anointed will rescue the poor when they cry out, and the oppressed when there is no one to help them.

A reading from the Younger Testament and Paul's letter to the Church in Ephesus.

For I, Paul—a prisoner of Christ Jesus for the sake of you Gentiles—am sure that you have heard of God's grace, of which I was made a steward on your behalf; this mystery, as I have briefly described it, was given to me by revelation. When you read this, you can understand my insight into the mystery of Christ, which was unknown to the people of former ages, but is now revealed by the Spirit to the holy apostles and prophets. That mystery is that the Gentiles are heirs, as are we; members of the Body, as are we; and partakers of the promise of Jesus the Messiah through the Good News, as are we.

I became a minister if the Good News by the gift of divine grace given me through the working of God's power. To me, the least of all believers, was given the grace to preach to the Gentiles the unfathomable riches of Christ and to enlighten all people on the mysterious design which for ages was hidden in God, the Creator of all.

Then Looks Brave (HEROD) called a secret council with the Seekers of Wisdom (MAGI) to find out when the star first appeared. He then sent them to the House of Bread (BETHLEHEM) and told them, "Look everywhere for

the child. Find him and tell me where he is, so that I may also come and honour him."

After Listening to Looks Brave (HEROD), the Seekers of Wisdom (MAGI) went their way. When they saw the star rising in the East, they jumped for joy, and with glad hearts they followed until the star stopped and rested over the place where the child was. They went into the house and saw the child and his mother, Bitter Tears (MARY). As soon as they saw the child they bowed down to honour him. Then they opened their bundles and gifted him with gold, sweet-smelling incense, and bitter ointment of myrrh. The Seekers of Wisdom (MAGI) were warned in a dream not to go back to Looks Brave (HEROD), so they returned to their homeland by a different road.
